## An example of an Examination of Conscience:

Begin with a prayer asking the Holy Spirit to see you as God sees you. Ask for the courage to confess what is needed. Then ask yourself questions such as these:

- DO I MAKE ANYONE OR ANYTHING MORE IMPORTANT TO ME THAN GOD? DO I TAKE TIME TO PRAY EACH DAY?
- DO I USE GOD'S NAME RESPECTFULLY AND AVOID CURSING AND SWEARING?
- DO I PARTICIPATE IN MASS EACH SUNDAY OR SATURDAY EVENING?
- AM I RESPECTFUL OF OTHERS?
- AM I FAITHFUL TO MY MARRIAGE VOWS (IF MARRIED)?
- DO I WORK TO HELP THE POOR, OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS, AND NEIGHBORS WHO NEED SPECIAL ATTENTION?
- DO I AVOID ANYTHING THAT WOULD HARM MY BODY OR OTHERS?
- HAVE I BEEN SELFISH?
- HAVE I STOLEN ANYTHING? HAVE I ABUSED OR FAILED TO RETURN ITEMS I BORROWED?
- AM I TRUTHFUL? HAVE I BEEN FAIR AND HONEST WITH FRIENDS, FAMILY, NEIGHBORS AND CO-WORKERS?
- HAVE I BEEN HAPPY FOR OTHERS WHEN THEY HAVE THINGS THEY WANT OR NEED, OR AM I JEAL-OUS?
- DO I AVOID EXCESSIVE USE OF ALCOHOL?
- DO I AVOID SITUATIONS THAT I KNOW WILL LEAD ME TO SIN?
- HAVE I MADE GOD MY TREASURE RATHER THAN MATERIAL POSSESSIONS?
