It has been over a week since we have been able to celebrate Mass together as parish family. Despite the restrictions at this time, know that you are not alone. You are not left as orphans. Each of you is kept in prayer every day!

On Fridays, we ask you to pray the Stations of the Cross, at 8 pm, or any other time. **A special set of Stations is being posted on our parish website—a set that pertains specifically to what we are currently experiencing.** It was received from India.

This season and what we experience now, should fill us with the same hope and trust that early Christians were filled with. **These are not my words, but God’s. (Read Psalm 91). WE ARE NEVER ALONE!**
