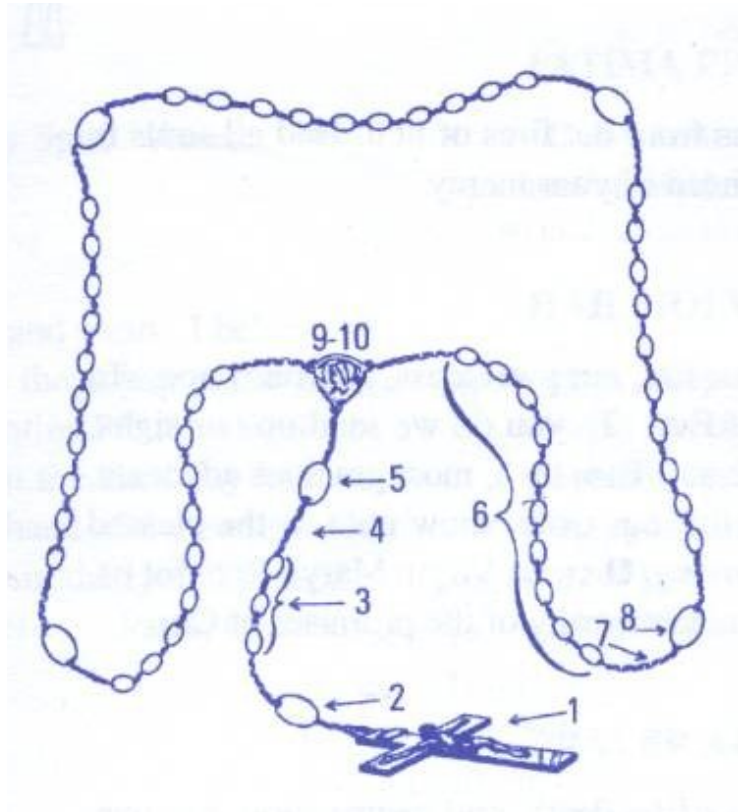


# How to Pray the Rosary



1. Sign of the Cross and Apostles Creed
2. Our Father
3. Three Hail Marys
4. Glory Be
5. Announcement Mystery and then Our Father
6. Ten Hail Marys
7. Glory Be & Fatima Prayer
8. (Repeat #5-7 until all beads are completed.)
- 9-10. Hail Holy Queen and Optional Prayer After Rosary

**Fatima Prayer:** O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, especially those in most need of thy mercy.

**Hail Holy Queen:** Hail, holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, o most gracious Advocate, thine eyes of mercy toward us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the Blessed Fruit of thy Womb, Jesus, o clement, o loving, o sweet Virgin Mary. Pray for us, o Holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

**Optional Prayer after Rosary:** O God, who by his life, death and resurrection has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant we beseech thee, that meditating upon these mysteries in the most holy rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, that we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.
