"He was a Samaritan." In this Sunday's Gospel we hear the familiar story of the ten in need of healing and only the outsider is the one who came back "glorifying God in a loud voice!" The emphasis often in the scripture on the unusual suspect, the ones who are not part of the in-crowd, God's people, is intentional and something Christ went out of His way to serve as a sign to us all that are meant to be together not divided.

The struggle in human relationships is that there are certain people who are seemingly harder to love than others. This is often due to our own baggage our own brokenness as much as it is theirs. Unfortunately, for many of us, we'd much rather remain divided than seek the healing that is needed to bring us together.

The brokenness of human relationships seems to be taking front stage in our news these days. With of three years of War in Gaza and more than that in Ukraine, with assassinations happening seemingly everyday and conflict found around every corner this division amongst humans seems beyond repair. Yet, Christ came to heal our brokenness, to mend divisions, to do the impossible, bring us all together as one.

It has been over three years since we have been brought together as a four parish community and it has been a blessing but not without its struggles. I wanted to thank you all for your work and openness to this opportunity for unity. The invitation for us all from the Lord is not simply to get along but to allow him to heal the brokenness that still divides. This process takes time but I pray we are all willing to let the Lord work in our community.

I encourage us all to take the effort to share in the four parish life and faith. There has been in increased amount of opportunities to come together and share our faith and life. One of those is our four parish directory. I encourage all to take this opportunity to help grow our unity. This resource is a great gift for us especially for those from other parishes who might not know us all. Please take the time to sign up for a photo this month if anything for the sake of unity.

I am also grateful for the work our four parish unity committee is doing to forward this cause. With their guidance and help we have identified a name for our four parish community. When we are referring to the four parishes as a whole moving forward we will be called the "One Family Catholic Community". Practically this helps identify us without having to use all for parish names but spiritually it expresses our desire and Christs to be one in faith as Catholics and as children of God. Please note that we will be sharing this information along with our new logo in the weeks to come.

Let us to side God for His healing power and His grace to make us one!






