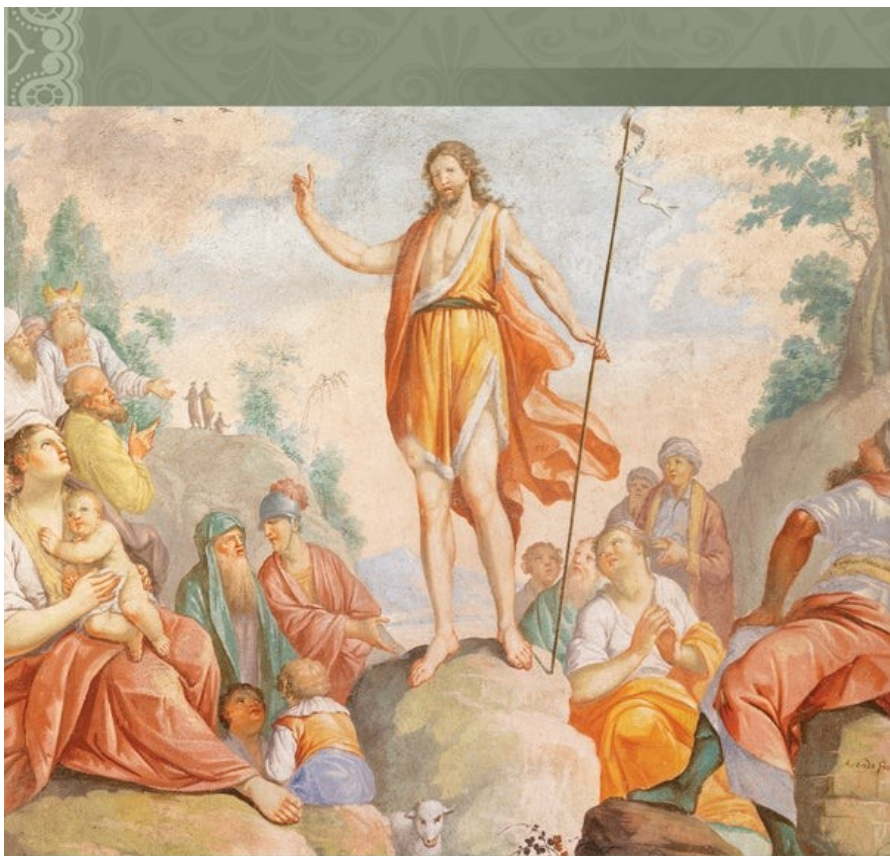

Blessed Advent to you all! As the great advent song proclaims “on Jordan’s bank the Baptist’s cry announces that the Lord is nigh!” We hear this same call again from our Gospel for this the second Sunday of Advent. “Awake and harken for he brings glad tidings of the King of Kings!” The challenge of Advent continues to be that of, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

The tendency for many is see the changes that should or should not be made by others and we are less inclined to make the same judgement for ourselves. This voice of John encourages a deeper introspective look at our own souls and the places God is calling us to reorder.

This process has been something that many of our leadership members have been undertaking on a 4-parish level. We recognize a continued call to unity in our Catholic faith and in the pursuit of this gift of faith. Out of this prayer, discernment and discussion we have developed a name for our 4-parish cluster, along with a logo and especially a mission. Though all four parishes will remain unique parish communities, each one called to a particular communal life of holiness, we recognize the communal nature our four parishes now share since we have been clustered. This gift of community is something we, the leadership and myself, desire to encourage and embrace as we have been called by our pope through his motto, “In Illo Uno Unum” In The One We Are One.”

This call to oneness, to unity, comes directly from our Lord and is an area we have recognized as an area we are all being called, by the voice in the desert, to repent, to change, to grow in. This call has inspired our name for our four parishes: ONE FAMILY CATHOLIC COMMUNITY. This title will be the name we use when referring to our 4-parish cluster in our joint initiatives like our shared bulletin and other shared communications, our shared communities, our shared office and staff, and the like. This Advent season I pray we may continue to reflect on the ways God is calling a change in us both as One Family Catholic Community as well as individually.

Let us especially pray for both Our Lady of Perpetual Help and Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary as they celebrate the success of their building projects and fundraising initiatives this weekend. I give thanks to God for all the support and generosity we have received in this mission to make our churches a place for all who are called to encounter God!

I also invite you all to our next Discipleship Gathering on the 14th of December which starts after the 10:30am mass at Holy Rosary. Danielle Hendrichs will be speaking on the call of fraternity and unity as disciples.

I ask for prayers for my brothers, Fr. Adam Laski and Fr. David Neuschwander and I as we travel to Djibouti to visit our brother Fr. Samuel Schneider as he serves the naval base there as a Navy Chaplain. I will be gone from the 8th to the 18th of December.

Finally, I encourage all to celebrate the feast of The Immaculate Conception on the 8th, a holy day of obligation. Let us pray to the patroness of our country for her intercession.
