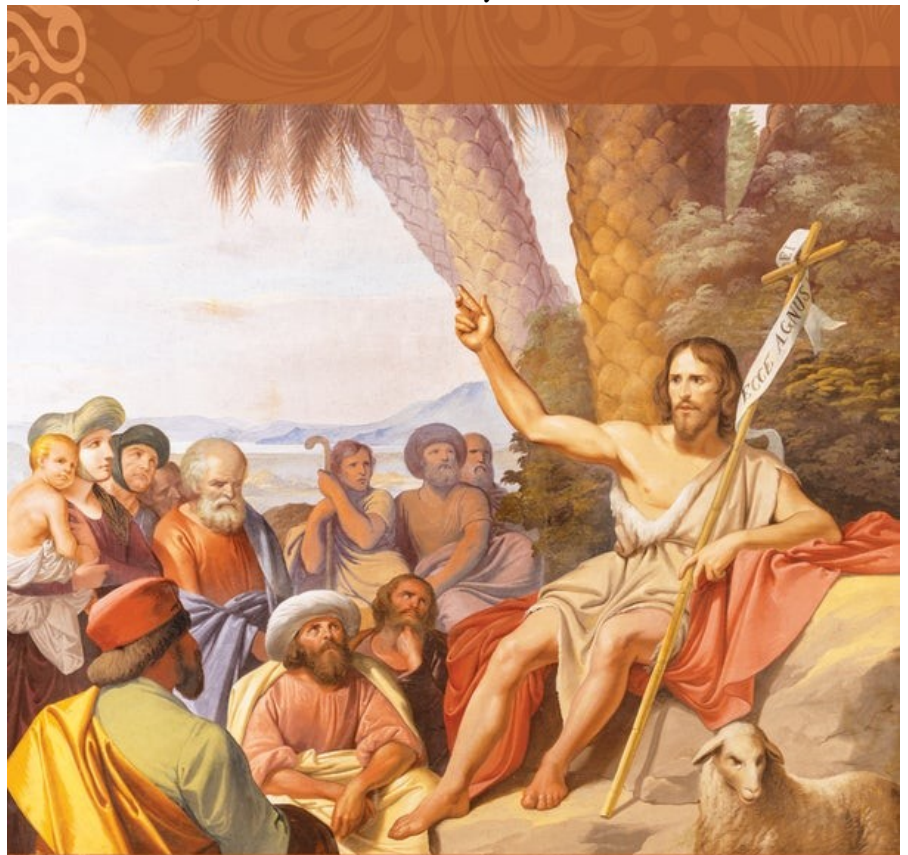

Blessed Advent!!! "Are you the one who is to come or should we look for another?" This question from John the Baptist speaks to a genuine struggle we all have when it comes to recognizing Christ's presence in our midst. Even John, of whom it was said "Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you, he will prepare your way before you," struggled to recognize Jesus for who he was when John was struggling. Jesus is coming and is already here, how are we struggling to recognize His presence amongst us. In a Church that only 1/3 recognize Christ as the true presence in the Eucharist we are called to not only recognize Him for who He truly is, Emmanuel, God with us, but also to witness His presence amongst us.

As we continue to grow together as individual parishes as well as One Family Catholic Community the leadership of our parish has come together to form a logo that represents our united parish community. This logo in a circle represented the united reality of our lives, centered on Christ in the Catholic Church. The church window is a reminder of not simply our church buildings but the presence of Christ in not only our buildings but the Body of Christ, the Church. The design of our logo also gives reference to the host as a central place where we encounter Christ in the Eucharist.

Though we are one we are many parts, each symbol in the logo represents the four parishes of our One Family Catholic Community. The Lamb of God represents the Good Shepherd parish in Rib Lake; the heart represents Sacred Heart of Jesus parish in Stetsonville; the image of Mary represents Our Lady of Perpetual Help parish in Whittlesey; the rosary represents Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary parish in Medford. These four are one in Christ in the Church, in the Eucharist, and in the mission of bringing Christ to all.

The world needs to know that Christ is the one who is to come just as John needed to know. It is our mission, as one, to reveal this truth to the world. As we continue to grow closer to Christ this Advent season as one, let us seek to be that witness, pointing all to Christ as not only the reason for this season, but the reason for all that we have. The reason for our hope, our love and our life.

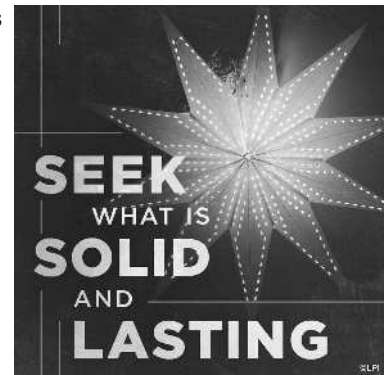

3rd Week of Advent

The 3rd Sunday of Advent is known as **Gaudete Sunday**, a day of rejoicing that signals Christmas is near. This is symbolized by lighting the third candle on the Advent wreath, which is often pink, representing joy, such as the joy of the shepherds. During Gaudete Sunday, the Church takes a break from the more somber tone of Advent to celebrate the joy of the impending birth of Jesus and the promise of his return. This reminds us that Advent is a season of “expectant joy” as our anticipation of the great joy of Christmas builds every day as we draw closer to it.

What is Scrip?

Scrip is a common and completely safe method of fundraising that has been around for years. The purpose of Holy Rosary’s Scrip Program is to help Holy Rosary School easily fundraise and directly decrease tuition costs for families. It also helps fundraise for the school which helps keep overall tuition lower.

The fundraising happens because local and national vendors sell their gift cards to Holy Rosary at a discount. Holy Rosary passes along that discount in the form of a tuition discount to the families who buy gift cards. You buy a vendor’s gift card at face value and it is worth what you paid.

When you purchase Scrip, you are purchasing gift cards that are used just like cash. You can use Scrip to purchase everyday items such as groceries, clothing, gas, and restaurant meals. Every Scrip purchase earns a rebate that can be donated to Holy Rosary. Good News for all! Rebates earned from buying gift cards helps pay for tuition.

Now is a great time to buy SCRIP for your holiday grocery purchases, fuel fills, and Christmas gifts!

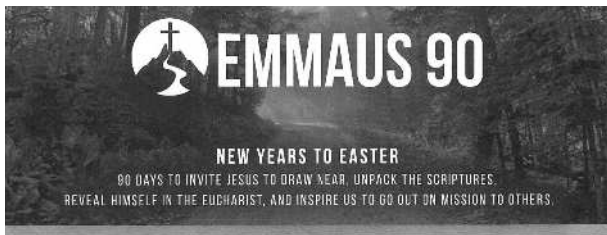

Use the cards to pay for your weekly items (gas, groceries, restaurants), pay for special purchases (holiday meal supplies), or give as gifts. Our most popular cards are Kwik Trip In Store: 15%, Culvers: 10%, Kwik Trip Gas: 5%, County Market: 4%, and Walmart: 2.5%. Cards are available in the entry before and after weekend Masses. We have most local stores' cards in stock and can special order many others. **SPECIAL ORDERS MUST BE PLACED BY 12/14 TO BE RECEIVED BEFORE CHRISTMAS.**
