Father Patrick

“Lord, it is good that we are here.” These are the words of Peter in our Gospel when he is faced with the transfiguration. The goodness of Jesus and the gift of the life He promises is attractive; it's good, and it's something we should desire. I've always found the transfiguration to be an interesting Gospel to reflect on and pray with during Lent. Aren't we supposed to be suffering with the Lord through the desert, not glorified on a mountain top?

Our parishes are currently going through the process of developing goals for the next year and beyond. This process is challenging because it requires not only for us to identify the areas of needed growth, but to agree on them. The leadership of our parishes, especially our Pastoral Council, Finance Council, and Trustees, is being asked to ask the question, in light of our mission, what are we being called to do next? As I have been having these conversations, I have to admit I was wondering, “What happens if there isn't a future? What does the future really hold?”

Forward thinking is healthy, matter of fact, it is what gives us hope, one of the three theological virtues, and for all of us in the desert, looking forward is extremely important. Today, the Church recognizes that the only way we will be successful in this life, this Lent, is if we are aware of the future promised for all who remain faithful in the desert. The transfiguration is exactly that, a glimpse at the future, the promise of life to come, THE reason for our hope.

Though Lent is a time to accept and invite the Lord into our suffering, into our struggles with sin, into our desert, where is Christ inviting us to go to the mountain with Him? Where do we encounter the transfiguration, the moments where our hope in Christ is renewed? These moments are profoundly important if we hope to carry out our goals, Lenten and beyond.

It is for this reason that this Lent we are emphasizing the importance of Adoration, a place of encounter with the Lord. We are also simplifying the Mass to emphasize the primary encounter we have with Christ in this most sacred Liturgy. We are simplifying music during the liturgy so that our worship reflects the nature of Lent. We are using the chant Mass, reducing the use of instruments, and refraining from the closing hymn. The introduction by the USCCB states that a closing hymn is optional (#147) and that instruments during Lent should be reduced to only organ and other instruments if needed (#313). We are called to reduce the things that are not needed so as to focus our senses on Christ, especially in the Mass. Let us keep Christ in mind in all things, as the goal!

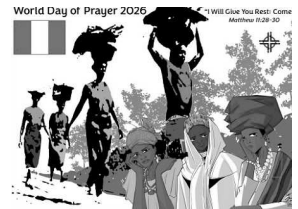

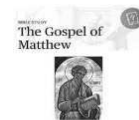
