Father Patrick

I write today's article in the city of Superior, preparing for the Chrism Mass with the Bishop. As I reflect on this day, I recognize in a very tangible way the universal nature of the Church. This Easter, we are being given the greatest gift, Jesus Christ, and the life that is found only in Him. This gift has been and will always be freely given. As we have taken time to prepare our hearts this previous Lent, I pray that we will take time this Easter to receive Him more fully and live fully in Him who is our life!

I would also like to invite you all to our upcoming fundraiser for our school this coming weekend, April 11, at 5:30pm at the Simek Center. I encourage your support of this important mission of our Church. Call the office or come to get tickets.

I would finally like to encourage us all to enter into the mystery of Christ's mercy. This last Friday began the Novena to the Divine Mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ. This novena ends on the feast of Divine Mercy, which is on April 12th this year, always the weekend after Easter. We invite you to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet this week. There will be Novena pamphlets at the entrance of our four churches. We will be praying the chaplet after all weekday Masses as well as before each weekend Mass on the 11th and 12th of April. Also, there will be a 3:00pm service for Divine Mercy at Our Lady of Perpetual Help. Please join us for all or some of this profound devotion to Christ's love for us.

May you all have a blessed Easter, and may the risen Lord be with you and your families.
