Divine Mercy Sunday: "Peace Be With You"

This Sunday, the Church celebrates **Divine Mercy Sunday**, a day that flows directly from the grace of Easter. In the Gospel, we encounter the risen Christ appearing to His disciples, speaking those powerful words: "*Peace be with you.*" He comes not with condemnation, but with mercy—showing His wounds, breathing the Holy Spirit upon them, and instituting the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Even in the face of doubt, as with Thomas, Jesus meets His disciples with patience and love.

This is the heart of Divine Mercy: that no sin, no doubt, no fear is greater than the mercy of Christ. He does not wait for us to be perfect—He comes to us in our weakness and invites us to trust in Him. As He said to St. Faustina, "*Jesus, I trust in You.*"

We warmly invite all parishioners to experience this mercy in a special way at our Divine Mercy celebration on **Sunday, April 12, at 3:00pm at Our Lady of Perpetual Help**. Together we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet, adore the Blessed Sacrament, and entrust ourselves more deeply to the mercy of Christ. This is a beautiful opportunity to receive grace, healing, and renewed peace.

At the same time, we are blessed to reflect on the witness of one of our own, **Fr. Casimir Cypher**, a martyr from Medford whose cause for canonization is underway. His life is a powerful testimony to trust in God even in the face of suffering. Like the apostles in this Sunday's Gospel, he encountered the mercy of Christ and responded with courage and fidelity. His witness reminds us that holiness is not reserved for the few—it is a call given to each of us.

To learn more about his inspiring life, all are invited to a special presentation on **Monday, April 13 at 6:00pm at Holy Rosary Parish**. This talk, presented by Fray Juan, will deepen our understanding of Fr. Casimir's life and encourage us to live our own call to holiness more fully.

Finally, a sincere word of gratitude to all who attended, supported, and helped make possible the **Celebration for Education** fundraiser for our Catholic School at Holy Rosary. Your generosity and dedication are a true witness to the vitality of our parish and the importance of forming our young people in the faith. Please know of our continued prayers and encouragement as we work together to strengthen Catholic education in our community.

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday, let us open our hearts to the peace Christ offers, trust more deeply in His mercy, and be inspired by the example of those who have gone before us in faith.

The cost of the conference, hotel, transportation and meals is over \$400. **Due our fundraising and some amazing donors we only charge the students fifty dollars.** This year's conference is July 10 to July 12. First Communion practice at Holy Rosary is on Wednesday, April 22, at 5:30pm. 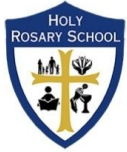
