Father Patrick

“The sheep hear his voice... and they follow him.” (John 10:27)

This Fourth Sunday of Easter — Good Shepherd Sunday — gives us a simple but powerful image: Jesus knows His sheep, and His sheep know His voice. He is not distant from us. He calls each of us personally and desires to draw us into deeper communion with Him.

For us as Catholics, that communion is most perfectly lived in the Holy Eucharist. But there are times when someone may not be able to receive Holy Communion—whether that’s because they need to go to Confession, are not in full communion with the Church, or for other reasons. That can be a difficult moment. It should be. It reminds us how great a gift the Eucharist truly is.

At the same time, the Church reminds us that we are never cut off from Christ. One of the most important practices in those moments is **spiritual communion**—a prayerful desire to receive Jesus, inviting Him to come into our hearts even when we cannot receive Him sacramentally.

A simple and beautiful prayer many have found helpful is:

“My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You.

Amen.”

If you ever find yourself remaining in the pew during Communion, don’t check out. That’s actually a moment to lean in—make that act of spiritual communion with sincerity. The Lord meets you there.

Along with that, there are other ways to stay engaged at Mass and grow in holiness:

- Listen attentively to the Word of God and reflect on it
- Offer your own prayers and sacrifices quietly during Mass
- Spend time with the Lord outside of Mass, especially before the Blessed Sacrament
- Pray the Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet regularly

These aren’t replacements for the Eucharist—but they prepare us for it and keep our hearts close to the Lord.

This weekend, we also celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday in a special way within our own One Family Catholic Community as **Good Shepherd Parish in Rib Lake** marks its feast day. Please keep our parish family there in your prayers. May Christ the Good Shepherd continue to guide and strengthen them—and all of us—as one family of faith, united in His care.

The Good Shepherd is always calling. The question is whether we are listening—and whether we are willing to follow.

Each Student Matters, Every Moment Counts, Christ in the Center

Our 4K preschoolers each received the book *If you Give a Pig a Pancake*, from the Taylor County Literacy Council. We have been celebrating The Week of the Young Child. Mrs. Easterly enjoyed reading the book to the students.



Our school recently completed the **Bullying Prevention Program** from Children’s Wisconsin. Through interactive, age-appropriate lessons, students learned how to recognize, prevent, and respond to bullying, with an emphasis on empathy, respectful behavior, and the role of bystanders. The program also addressed topics such as cyberbullying and building positive peer relationships. In addition, helpful parent resources were shared with families to support these conversations at home. Overall, the program reinforced our commitment to a safe, respectful, and supportive school environment.



We recently added God’s Friends Bench to our playground. The idea is to let all of our students know that the bench is a safe place. If there are times when a student feels like they have nobody to play with or maybe even feel they are being picked on but don’t want to go to the teacher on duty for recess, they can sit on this bench. What we are promoting is letting these students know that they can go to this bench and sit and then we hope to encourage other well-meaning students to check with these students and see if they can help them or maybe invite them to play with the other student or their group. This is a wonderful way to promote helping each other and hopefully establish new friendships.

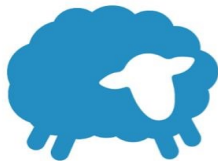
