Our readings for the Fifth Sunday of Easter should stir within us a deeper sense of faith. We are challenged to move from a place of comfort into a place of spiritual trust. This gift from God requires openness and acceptance. How will we know what the Lord wants for us, and from us, unless we place ourselves in a position of encounter?

We catch a glimpse of this bold witness in our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles. Seven men, chosen from the community, stepped forward to serve—placing their lives at the service of others without fully knowing where the Spirit would lead them. (As a side note, St. Stephen, recognized as the first Christian martyr, served as a deacon in the early Church.) These men gave powerful witness to the faith through their willingness to serve.

As many of you know, Fr. Julian, Fr. Adam Laski, and I returned a week ago from a silent retreat at Clear Creek Abbey, a Benedictine monastery in the Diocese of Tulsa, Oklahoma. I can only speak for myself, but I witnessed a similar self-giving as I spent my days among monks who devote themselves entirely to God—in silence, solitude, constant prayer, and willing penance.

Their witness of love for God and love for the Church was profound. It moved me to a place of deep joy and a renewed appreciation for every aspect of my faith. I don't say this lightly: this week-long silent retreat was a life-changing experience.

While I wish I could share everything with you, I want to leave you with two key thoughts:

First: You never know how God will move or whom He will use to draw you closer to Him. Trust in faith that He is at work. Be open. Believe.

Second: God is relentlessly pursuing a relationship with each one of us. The power of your "yes" is all He needs to change your life forever.

As Matthew Kelly so often says... "Trust. Surrender. Receive. Believe."

Blessings to you, and continue to live in the joy of the Easter mysteries.

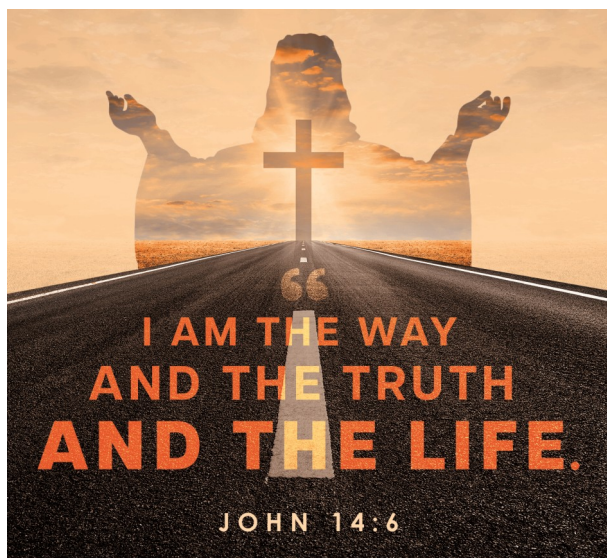
