As we celebrate Pentecost, we recall the moment when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles. He filled them with courage, wisdom, and zeal to proclaim the Gospel. Pentecost is often called the “birthday of the Church” because it marks the beginning of the Church’s mission. The same Holy Spirit given to the Apostles continues to guide and strengthen the Church today. He calls each of us to live our faith boldly and share the love of Christ through our words, actions, and witness.

We also extend congratulations to all of this year’s graduates and assure them of our prayers as they begin a new chapter in life.

As summer begins, may it be a time of rest, renewal, family joy, and continued growth in faith for all of our students and families. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit will watch over all of our parishioners, teachers, staff, and young people, keeping them safe and drawing them ever closer to Christ.

Please also keep Scott Pederson and Carl Oman in your prayers as they prepare for ordination to the Transitional Diaconate for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Superior. We congratulate them on this important step toward priestly ministry and ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen them in their vocation. We are also pleased to welcome Carl Oman to our parish communities this summer, where he will be serving our four parishes as a deacon during his summer assignment.

May this Pentecost renew in each of us the fire of the Holy Spirit so that we may continue the mission entrusted to the Church with faith, courage, and joy.

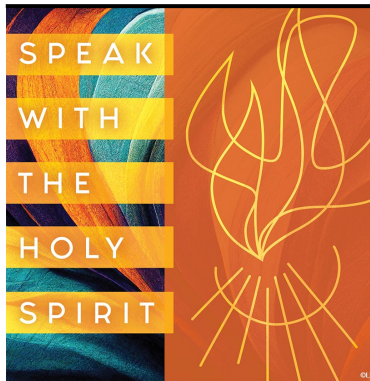

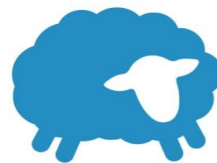

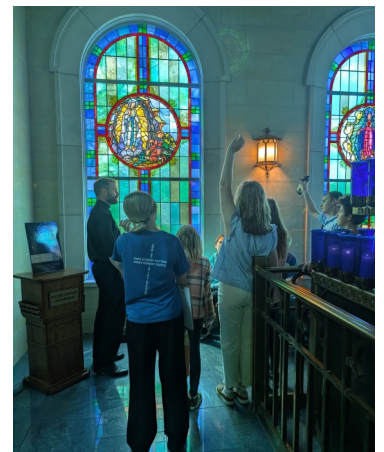

Gospel Meditation

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

May 24, 2026 - Pentecost Sunday - John 20:19-23

"He breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.

Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.'" (John 20:22-23)

For those of us who go to confession regularly, there is often a familiar frustration: "Why do I keep confessing the same sins?" It can feel like a loop, cleansed but unchanged. Pentecost reveals a hopeful perspective. When the Risen Jesus breathes on his ashamed and fearful disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit, he echoes Genesis, when God breathes life into Adam. This is not just primarily the removal of guilt, but new creation.

In confession, we receive more than forgiveness. We receive a fresh outpouring, the breath of the Spirit, and a renewed mission. Jesus does not say to us, "You're forgiven, now go back to your old life." He says, so to speak, "**As the Father has sent me, so I send you.**" (John 20:21)

That is why penance is not just saying a few prayers. It is reorientation. It is the Spirit summoning us to live differently: with mercy and healing. Just as Adam was sent into the world, and the Apostles were sent out after Pentecost, so too we are sent from the confessional — not just clean, but consecrated.

Pentecost Challenge: After your next confession, ask the Holy Spirit for one way you can participate in Christ's healing will for you. Then take one small, concrete step, and do not look back.
