## Deacon Patrick Gierl

### GIFT

The joy of receiving a gift never goes out of style. When someone appreciates you enough to express it concretely it makes all the difference in the world. In contrast, casual relationships rarely inspire a desire to grow deeper or to remain present for anything beyond self-gratification. That is why I am often taken aback by the familiar sayings: “Mass is boring,” or “I don’t really get anything out of Mass.” For Catholic Christians, religion is not merely an abstract idea, a feeling, or a philosophy, it is a relationship—a relationship with a person: Jesus Christ. If we truly believe that, then how could we ever think of the Mass as anything other than GIFT? **The Holy Eucharist is the reality of One who appreciates us so deeply that He gives us His very self.** If you believe this, you will never leave. “So, could you not watch with me for one hour?” (Mt 26:40) The gift of self is the entire reality of the Mass and everything that flows from it. This is the center of our lives—the place where we discover **who we are** and **the path** to eternal life. The more we pour ourselves into this reality, the more substantial, life-giving, and clear it becomes. The world constantly tempts us with false ideologies and empty allurements. In doing so, it robs us of the very things we crave most deeply: peace, joy, and clarity. **WE ARE MADE FOR THE LORD AND THE TRUEST WAY TO COMMUNE WITH HIM OUTSIDE OF MASS IS A HOLY HOUR.** What is a holy hour, and how does it work? First, don’t overcomplicate it. A holy hour is simply an uninterrupted hour spent in the presence of the Eucharistic Lord. “But what would I even do sitting in silence before the Lord?” That is actually a beautiful first question to bring to Him. One of the greatest fears in the hearts of those who avoid this gift is what they might hear if they sit still long enough to listen to the voice of the Lord. “But Deacon, I just don’t have time to commit one hour a week to the Lord...” Of course, the evil one wants you to believe that lie. Still, if an hour feels impossible, then begin with five or ten minutes. Stop in and visit Him. When Jesus was in the Garden of Gethsemane, He asked His disciples for one thing: “Stay with me. Watch with me. Spend time with me.” When we reflect on the mission and sacrifices of the Twelve Apostles, our own lives begin to look rather safe by comparison. Archbishop Fulton Sheen once said of Eucharistic Adoration: “What you do during your holy hour matters much less than your commitment to it. Take the time.” There are countless ways to spend time with the Lord during Adoration: Pray the Rosary, Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet, Read Sacred Scripture, Study the lives of the saints, Read books that deepen your faith, Learn more about the Holy Eucharist and why Jesus says:

“Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have life within you.” (Jn 6:53), or simply sit quietly and BE with the Lord. How beautiful is that? I leave you with this question: Why should you experience the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration? Because the Lord wants your heart. And when He has your heart, He gains your soul; When He gains your soul, He directs your life, and when He directs your life, you receive greater peace, greater joy, and greater clarity.

**What gift could possibly be more valuable than that?**

Go fall in love with the Lord.

The tight community also helped me form stronger friendships with my classmates. Since we spent so much more time together in smaller groups, we were able to support each other both academically and personally. This sense of community reflected many of the values taught in the Catholic faith, such as kindness, respect, and caring for others.

As I move forward in life, I plan to continue building on the faith foundation that began at Holy Rosary. I hope to model myself after the values I learned there by treating others with respect, helping people when I can, and staying connected to my Catholic faith. Whether it is through attending Mass, staying involved in my parish community, or simply trying to live out the values I was taught, I want to continue growing in my faith.

## What is Scrip?

Scrip is a common and completely safe method of fundraising that has been around for years. The purpose of Holy Rosary's Scrip Program is to help Holy Rosary School easily fundraise and directly decrease tuition costs for families. It also helps fundraise for the school which helps keep overall tuition lower.

The fundraising happens because local and national vendors sell their gift cards to Holy Rosary at a discount. Holy Rosary passes along that discount in the form of a tuition discount to the families who buy gift cards. You buy a vendor's gift card at face value and it is worth what you paid.

When you purchase Scrip, you are purchasing gift cards that are used just like cash. You can use Scrip to purchase everyday items such as groceries, clothing, gas, and restaurant meals. Every Scrip purchase earns a rebate that can be donated to Holy Rosary. Good News for all! Rebates earned from buying gift cards helps pay for tuition.

## Gospel Meditation

### Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

*May 31, 2026 - The Most Holy Trinity - John 3:16-18*

I was 16 years old on a youth group retreat in the mountains. One night, I opened my heart to the message being proclaimed: that God so loved the world that He sent His Son for us. Later, I lay under the pine trees and looked up at the countless stars. They seemed different. No longer cold, distant balls of chemical reactions, they appeared as an expression of God's love, as if He were giving those stars directly to me. The truth of God sending His Son changed how I saw the whole universe.

That is what today's Gospel reveals: "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son." (John 3:16) The universe is not just a whirl of impersonal forces or empty space. At its heart is a gift: the Father eternally giving the Son, not to condemn, but to bring life.

This is not abstract doctrine but deeply personal. God gives His Son for you and me. Each human life is precious enough to be caught up in that eternal gift.

It is in the Mass where we encounter this most directly. In the Word proclaimed, in the assembly gathered, in the priest, and above all in the Eucharist, the Father once again gives His Son. What looks like bread and wine is the drama of the Trinity, laboring to love us here and now.

The Trinity is not a puzzle to solve but the blazing Truth at the center of everything: the Father gives the Son for you and me. Lord, help us to see this more clearly. ~ *Father John Muir*

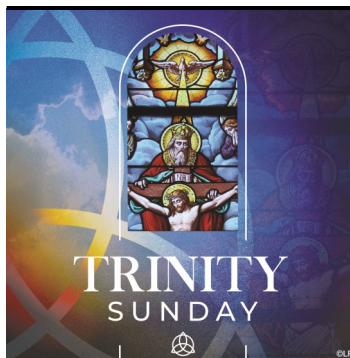
