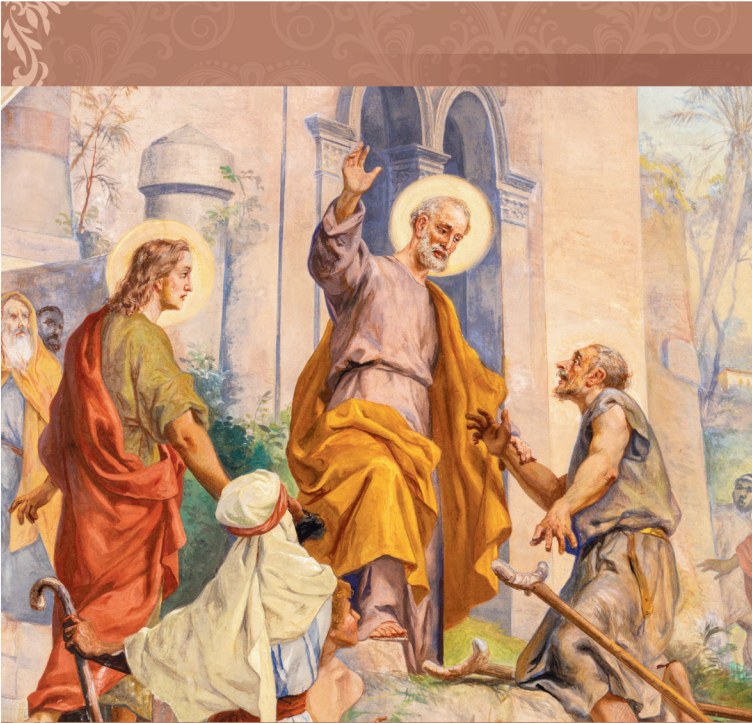

A NOTE FROM FR. PATRICK

Called to Make Disciples

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus looks upon the crowds with compassion because they are "troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd." He then tells His disciples, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest" (Matthew 9:37-38).

These words are not directed only to the Twelve Apostles. They are addressed to every baptized Christian. Each of us has been called by Christ to be His disciple and to help others come to know, love, and follow Him.

As a *One Family Catholic Community*, we have embraced the Diocese of Superior's vision of the Discipleship Pathway, which helps us understand how people grow in faith and how our parishes can accompany them on that journey. The pathway consists of four stages: Pre-Evangelization, Evangelization, Discipleship, and Apostolate.

Pre-Evangelization is about creating a sense of belonging and building relationships. Before many people are ready to hear the Gospel, they need to experience welcome, friendship, and authentic Christian community. Parish dinners, community events, hospitality ministries, and simple acts of kindness help prepare the soil for faith to take root.

Evangelization is the proclamation of the Good News of Jesus Christ. It is the moment when people are invited to encounter Christ personally and respond to His invitation to follow Him. Through the Mass, parish missions, retreats, personal witness, and prayer, hearts are opened to the transforming love of God.

Discipleship is the lifelong process of learning to follow Jesus. Through prayer, the Sacraments, Scripture, faith formation, and Christian fellowship, disciples grow in holiness and deepen their relationship with the Lord. This is where we learn not simply what Catholics believe, but how to live as faithful followers of Christ.

Apostolate is being sent on mission. Mature disciples recognize that their faith is not meant to be kept to themselves. They share Christ through their families, workplaces, schools, communities, and parish ministries. They become laborers in the Lord's harvest and help others begin the journey of discipleship.

Simply put, the pathway can be summarized as: Belong, Believe, Become, and Be Sent.

As we hear Jesus speak of the abundant harvest this weekend, we are invited to ask where we fit into this mission. Our four parishes need people willing to participate, assist, and lead at every stage of the discipleship pathway. Some are called to welcome and accompany others. Some are called to teach and mentor. Others are called to serve through liturgy, music, administration, maintenance, outreach, faith formation, or acts of charity. Every gift has a place in the mission of the Church.

The Lord continues to call laborers into His harvest. Let us pray not only for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and religious life, but also for a renewed spirit of missionary discipleship in our parish communities. May each of us be open to where Christ is calling us to serve, and may we respond generously, helping others take the next step on their journey toward Him.

The harvest is abundant. May we be faithful laborers in the Lord's vineyard.

After being involved with the Holy Rosary Parish for my whole life, I've been supported by many individuals who have helped me grow close to God. From religion class while I was in school, to CCD once I attended public school, Holy Rosary has always reinforced my faith. One of the most distinct memories I have from CCD was my Confirmation retreat during my junior year. During those two days, my faith grew astronomically because of the knowledge of the leaders around me. I felt comfortable talking about what I've been through and gained insight into ways to grow closer to God. 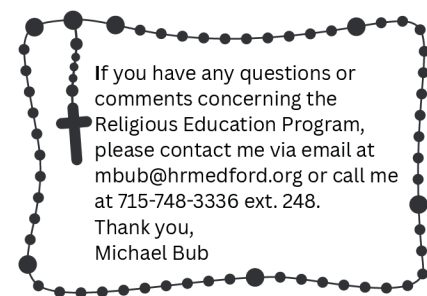

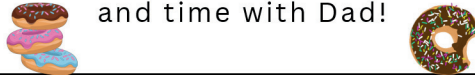
