## A NOTE FROM FR. PATRICK

On June 11, 2026, the Catholic bishops of the United States consecrated our nation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus as part of the celebration of our country's 250th anniversary. In this historic act, the bishops entrusted our nation, its people, and its future to the loving Heart of Christ, asking that He heal what is wounded, strengthen what is good, and guide us in the ways of truth, justice, charity, and peace.

As members of the One Family Catholic Community, we will join this national effort by offering 250 hours of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament leading up to Independence Day. We invite every parishioner to participate by spending time with Our Lord in prayer and helping us fulfill these 250 hours as a spiritual gift for our nation.

From June 26 through July 4, a special Nine-Day Novena to the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be prayed at 6:00 p.m. each evening at Holy Rosary. This time of prayer will include Adoration and the official novena prayers leading up to the national consecration. We strongly encourage all parishioners to make every effort to attend these 6:00 p.m. Holy Hours at Holy Rosary as we unite our hearts in prayer for our country.

In addition to the novena and feast day celebration, parishioners are encouraged to spend time in prayer during the regular Holy Hours throughout our One Family Catholic Community:

- Holy Rosary – Tuesdays from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Thursdays from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Sacred Heart – Wednesdays from 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Our Lady of Perpetual Help – Fridays from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.
- Good Shepherd – Tuesdays from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Every hour spent in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament counts toward our goal of 250 hours. Forms will be available at the Holy Hours in each of our parishes. We ask everyone to record the amount of time they spend in prayer so that we can share the total number of hours offered by our One Family Catholic Community with the bishops of the United States as part of this national effort. Whether you are able to pray for an hour, a half hour, or even a few minutes, your prayer is a valuable contribution and an act of love for our country.

As part of this national observance, the Prayer of Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be prayed at all Masses throughout our One Family Catholic Community on July 4 and July 5. We encourage all parishioners to unite themselves spiritually to this act of entrustment, asking the Lord to bless our nation and draw all people closer to His Sacred Heart.

In a time when our nation faces many challenges, the Sacred Heart reminds us that true renewal begins with conversion of heart. As Catholics, we are called not only to pray for our country but also to witness to Christ's love through lives of faith, charity, and discipleship. Let us ask the Sacred Heart of Jesus to bless America with peace, protect the dignity of every human person, strengthen our families, and guide our nation according to His will. Please remember to record your prayer time on the forms provided at each parish's Holy Hours so that every hour offered can be included in our community's total.

As we prepare to celebrate Independence Day, may our gratitude for the freedoms we enjoy lead us to pray fervently for our nation and entrust its future to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
