A NOTE FROM DEACON PAT

Walking the Path of Discipleship

Father Patrick recently invited our parish community to participate more fully in the diocesan initiative, Discipleship Pathways. This initiative provides opportunities for all Catholics to deepen their faith, strengthen our One Family Catholic Community, and support the mission of the Church. The readings for the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time remind us that discipleship involves supporting those who dedicate their lives to proclaiming the Gospel through our hospitality, prayers, and encouragement.

Three spiritual practices that can help us grow as disciples are consecration, novenas, and Eucharistic adoration. Consecration is the act of dedicating ourselves more fully to God through prayer, reflection, and a commitment to living according to His will. It encourages us to express our faith through daily actions and service to others while fostering unity within the Church. Novenas are a traditional Catholic devotion consisting of nine consecutive days of prayer for a particular intention. Whether prayed individually or with others, novenas deepen our trust in God and strengthen our spiritual lives through prayer, reflection, and perseverance.

Eucharistic Adoration offers a unique opportunity to spend time in the presence of Jesus Christ in the Blessed Sacrament. Through silent prayer and contemplation, we grow closer to Christ, receive spiritual renewal, and develop a deeper appreciation for the Eucharist. Adoration also strengthens our faith communities and encourages vocations within the Church.

A concrete example of all three of these spiritual practices is our current initiative to offer 250 hours of adoration in honor of the Sacred Heart of Jesus through July 4th at Holy Rosary. Please consider joining us in prayer for our church, our country, and the World At Large..

As we continue our journey through Discipleship Pathways, these spiritual practices can serve as powerful tools for growth in faith and service. By embracing consecration, participating in novenas, and spending time in Eucharistic adoration, we open our hearts more fully to God's grace and become stronger witnesses to Christ's love. May these practices inspire us to live as faithful disciples, united in prayer and committed to building up the Church for generations to come.

Holy Rosary School Spring 2026 NWEA MAP Growth Summary

Holy Rosary School is proud to celebrate another year of strong academic achievement and student growth as reflected in our Spring 2026 NWEA MAP assessment results. MAP (Measure of Academic Progress) assessments measure both student achievement and academic growth over time, providing valuable insight into how students are progressing and whether they are meeting or exceeding expected learning targets.

This year's results tell a powerful story:

Holy Rosary students are achieving at high levels while continuing to grow beyond expected rates. Multiple grade levels performed in the top 10-20% nationally, while many students met or exceeded their individualized growth targets.

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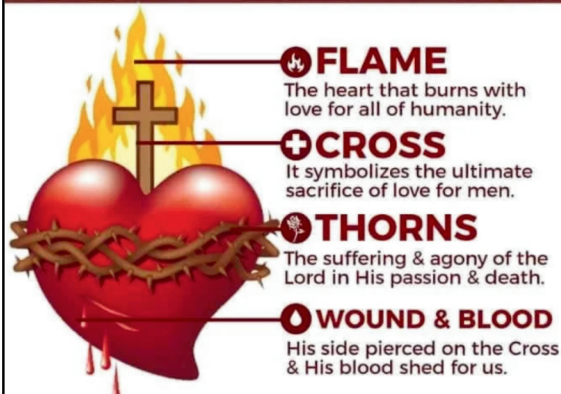
